Question No.13:

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Item Rubric (English) :

Listening and Speaking Instructions for Teacher:

- Call the students one by one.
- Take any two of the following “Consonant Clusters”. (one from the two-letter group, and one from three letters group)
- Pronounce them clearly and also give at least one-word example for each “Consonant Cluster”.
- Now, ask the student to repeat the same “Consonant Clusters” and say one word for each of them.
- Do not use the same letters for consecutive students.

Consonant Clusters:

Sp Fr Pl Sc
Spl Str Spr Scr

Sample Answer:

- Sp: Spoon, Sparrow, Sponge
- Fr: Fry, Friend, Frog
- Pl: Plane, Planet, Plate
- Sc: Scary, Scale, School
- Spl: Splash, Spleen, Splint
- Str: Strap, Straw, Streak
- Spr: Spray, Spring, Spread
- Scr: Screw, Screen, Scrap

Award of Marks:

- Each consonant Blend has two words.
- Each word carries 2 marks. So total 2x2= Marks (4)
- Award 2 marks for each correct answer.
- Award 0 marks for an irrelevant/ incorrect response.

Reading Instructions for the Teachers

- Call the students one by one
- Select any two words from the word bank and ask the students to read them loudly.
- Check if the student reads the word with the correct pronunciation and syllabic division.
- Make sure not to repeat the words for any two consecutive students.

Word Bank:

Comfortable, Religious, Sacrifice, Comprehension, Exhibition, Prominent, Cooperative, Behaviour, Architecture, Militant.

- Sac-ri-fice

- Co-op-er-a-tive

- Be-hav-iour
- Mil-i-tar-y

Award of Marks:

- Each word carries 2 marks.
- Award 2 marks if the child reads the word correctly with correct syllabic division.
- Award 1 mark if the child reads the word correctly without clear syllabic division.
- Award 0 marks for an irrelevant/ incorrect response.
